

1. HOW THEY HAVE JUDGED OTHERS. Vs. 1-3

"Therefore you are without excuse, everyman of you who passes judgment, for in that you judge another, you condemn yourself; for you who judge practice the same things. And we know that the judgment of God rightly falls upon those who practice such things." vs. 1-2

"And do you suppose this, O man, when you pass judgment upon those who practice such things and do the same yourself, that you will escape the judgment of God?" vs. 3

2. THEIR STUBBORN REFUSAL OF GOD'S GRACE.

"Or do you think lightly of the riches of His kindness and forbearance and patience, not knowing that the kindness of God leads you to repentance? But because of your stubbornness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God." vs. 4-5

3. THE IMPARTIALITY OF GOD. Vs. 6-11

"Who will render to every man according to his deeds: to those who by perseverance in doing good seek for glory and honor and immortality, eternal life; but to those who are selfishly ambitious and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, wrath and indignation." vs. 6-8

"There will be tribulation and distress for every soul of man who does evil, of the Jew first and also of the Greek, but glory and honor and peace to every man who does good, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. For there is no partiality with God." vs. 9-11

"...I most certainly understand now that God is not one to show partiality, but in every nation the man who fears Him and does what is right, is welcomed to Him." Acts 10:34-35

4. THEIR OWN CONSCIENCE. Vs. 12-16

"For all who have sinned without the Law will also perish without the Law; and all who have sinned under the Law will be judged by the Law; for not the hearers of the Law are just before God, but the doers of the Law will be justified." vs. 12-13

"For when Gentiles who do not have the Law do instinctively the things of the Law, these not having the Law, are a law to themselves, in that they show the work of the Law written in their hearts, their conscience bearing witness, and their thoughts alternately accusing or else defending them, on the day when, according to my gospel, God will judge the secrets of men through Christ Jesus." vs. 14-16

Your conscience is a God given ability to tell you what you OUGHT and OUGHT NOT to do.

Your conscience is helpful but flawed due to your sin nature.

Your conscience over time may become callous.

Your conscience may be renewed by the Holy Spirit and Scripture.
