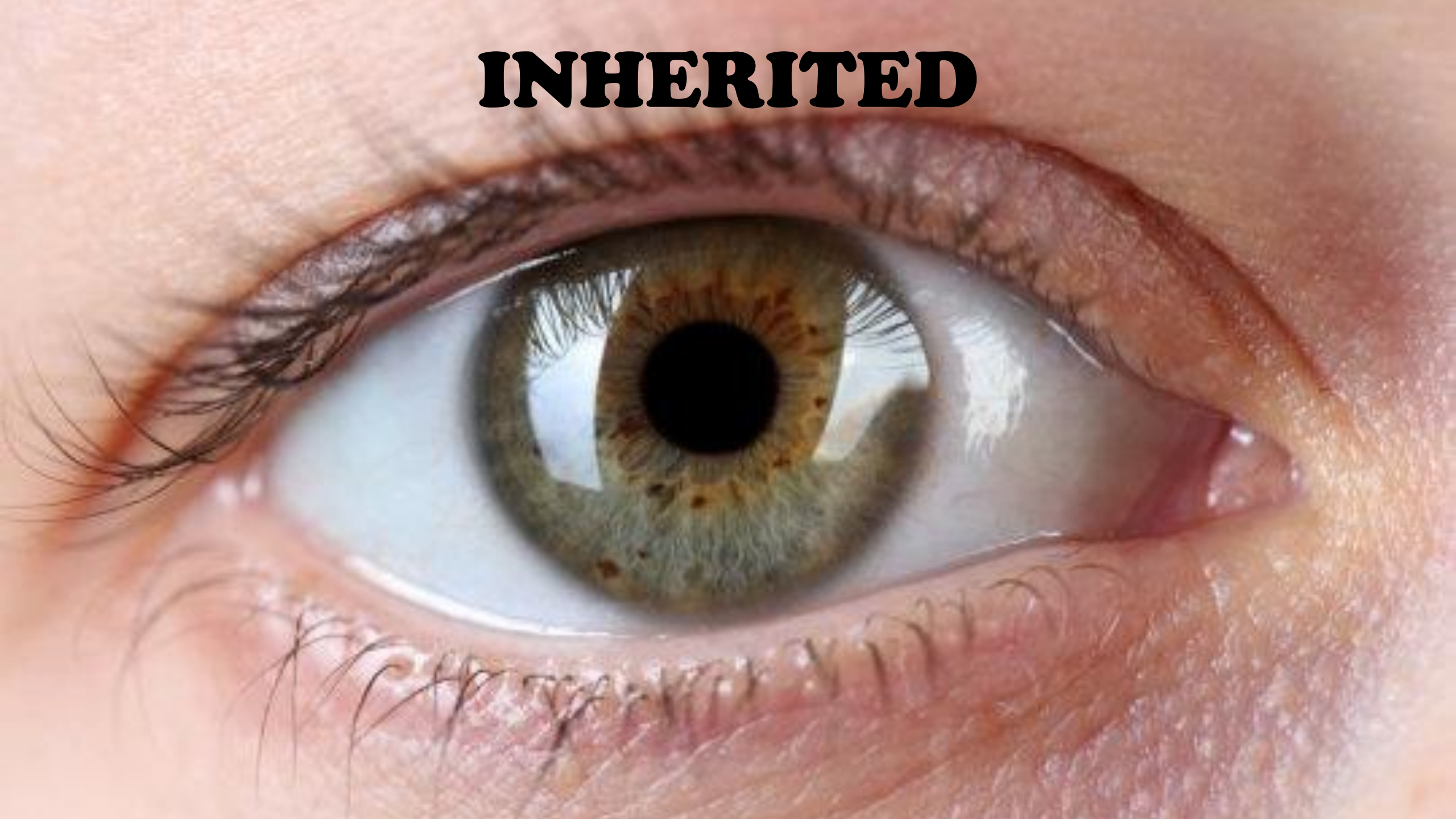

A. Adam: Death. Jesus: Abundant life.

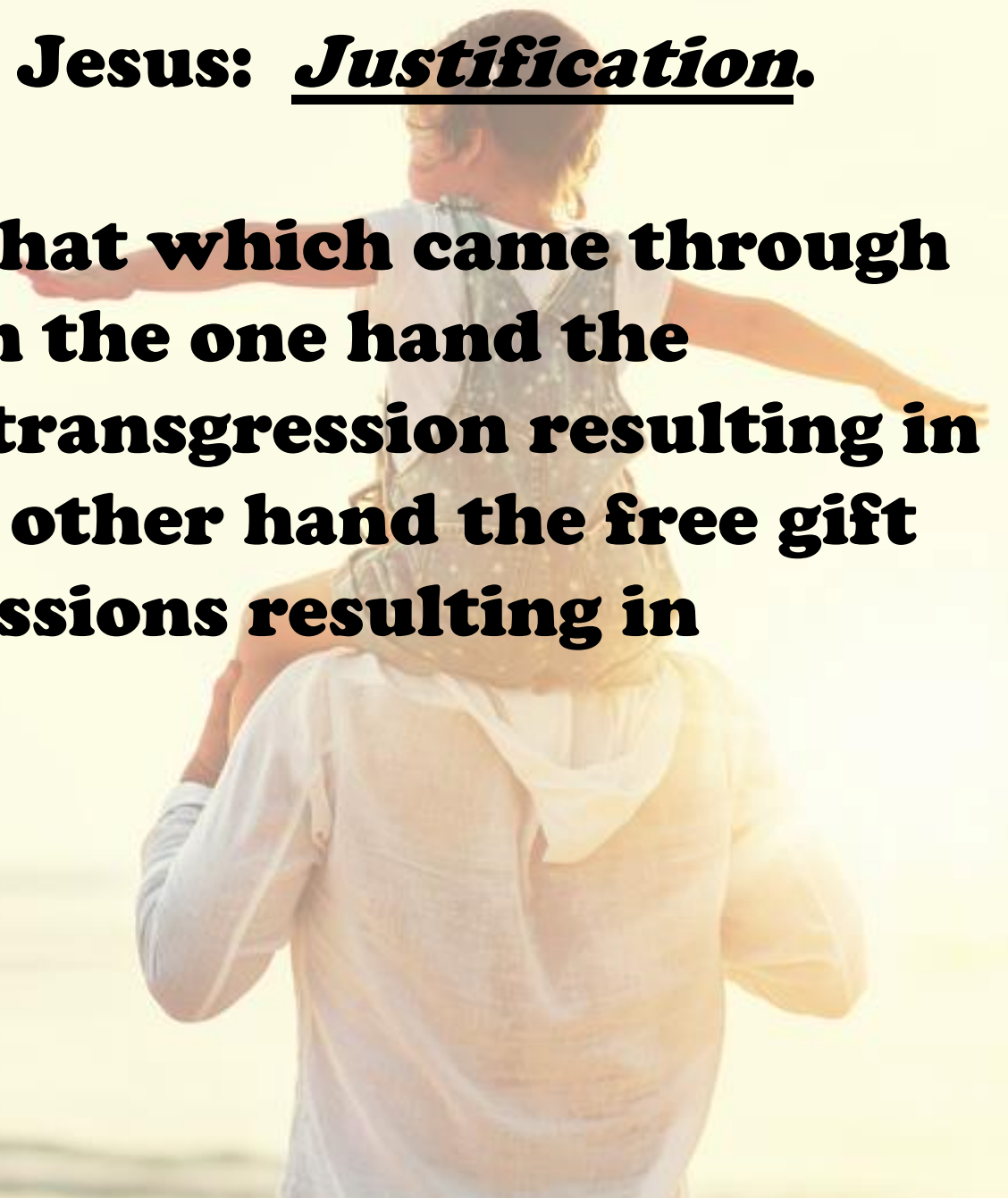
**“But the free gift is not like the transgression.

“And this is the promise which He Himself made to us: eternal life.” 1 John 2:25


B. Adam: condemnation. Jesus: Justification.

**C. Adam: a reign of death. Jesus: a reign of life.
Vs. 17-18**

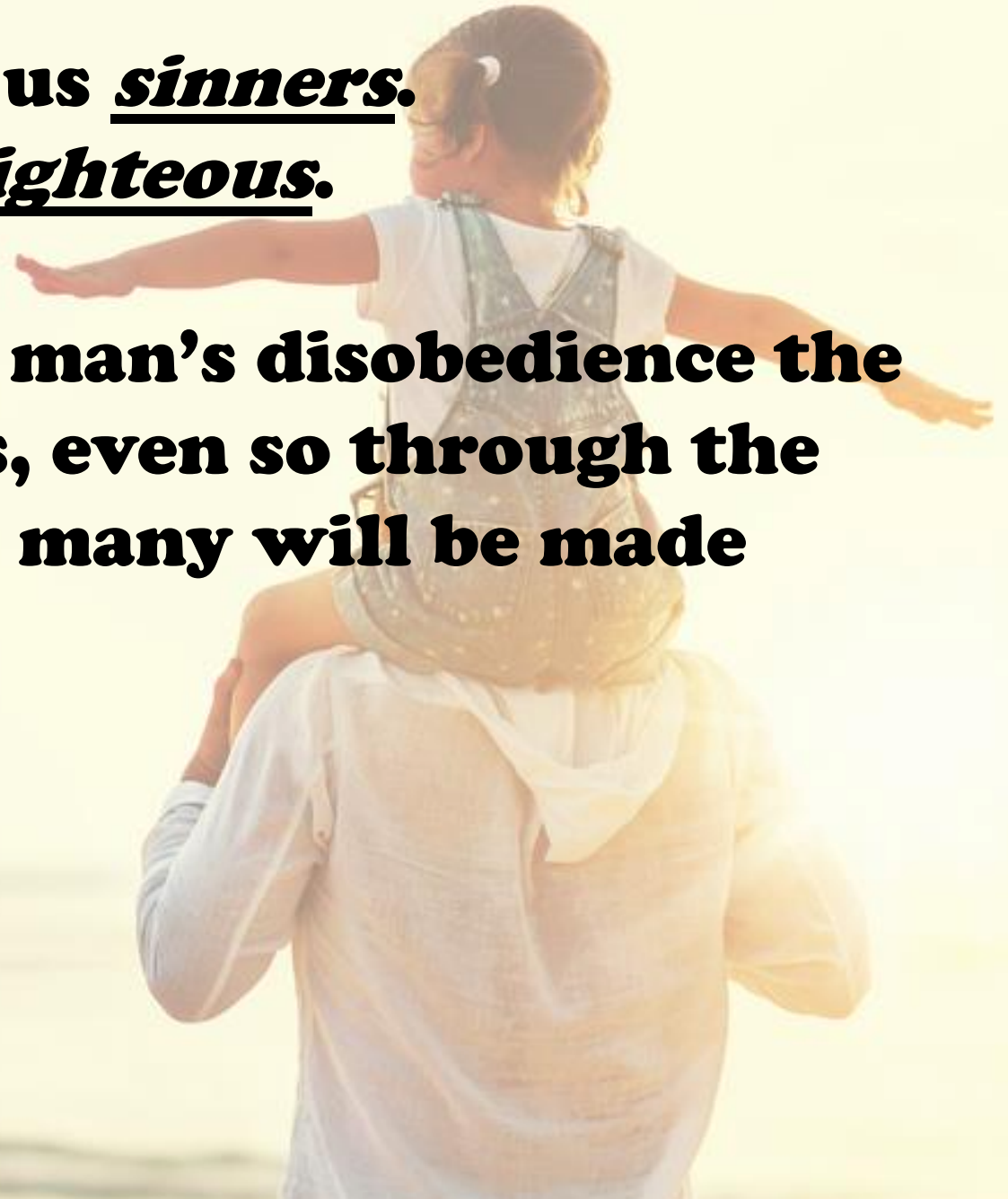
“For if by the transgression of the one, death reigned through the one, much more those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ. So then as through one transgression there resulted condemnation to all men, even so through one act of righteousness there resulted justification of life to all men.” vs. 17-18

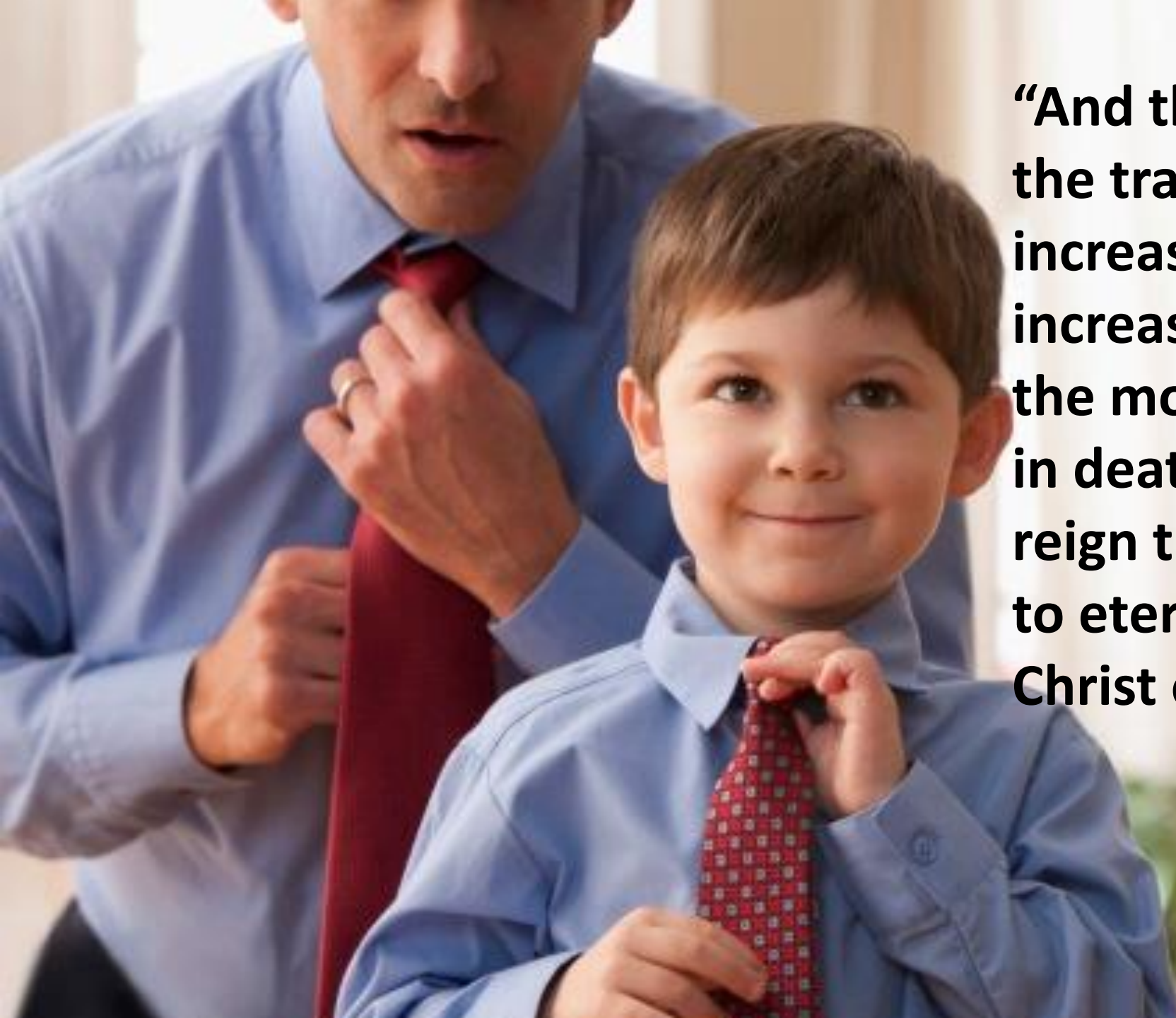
**D. Adam's one act made us sinners.

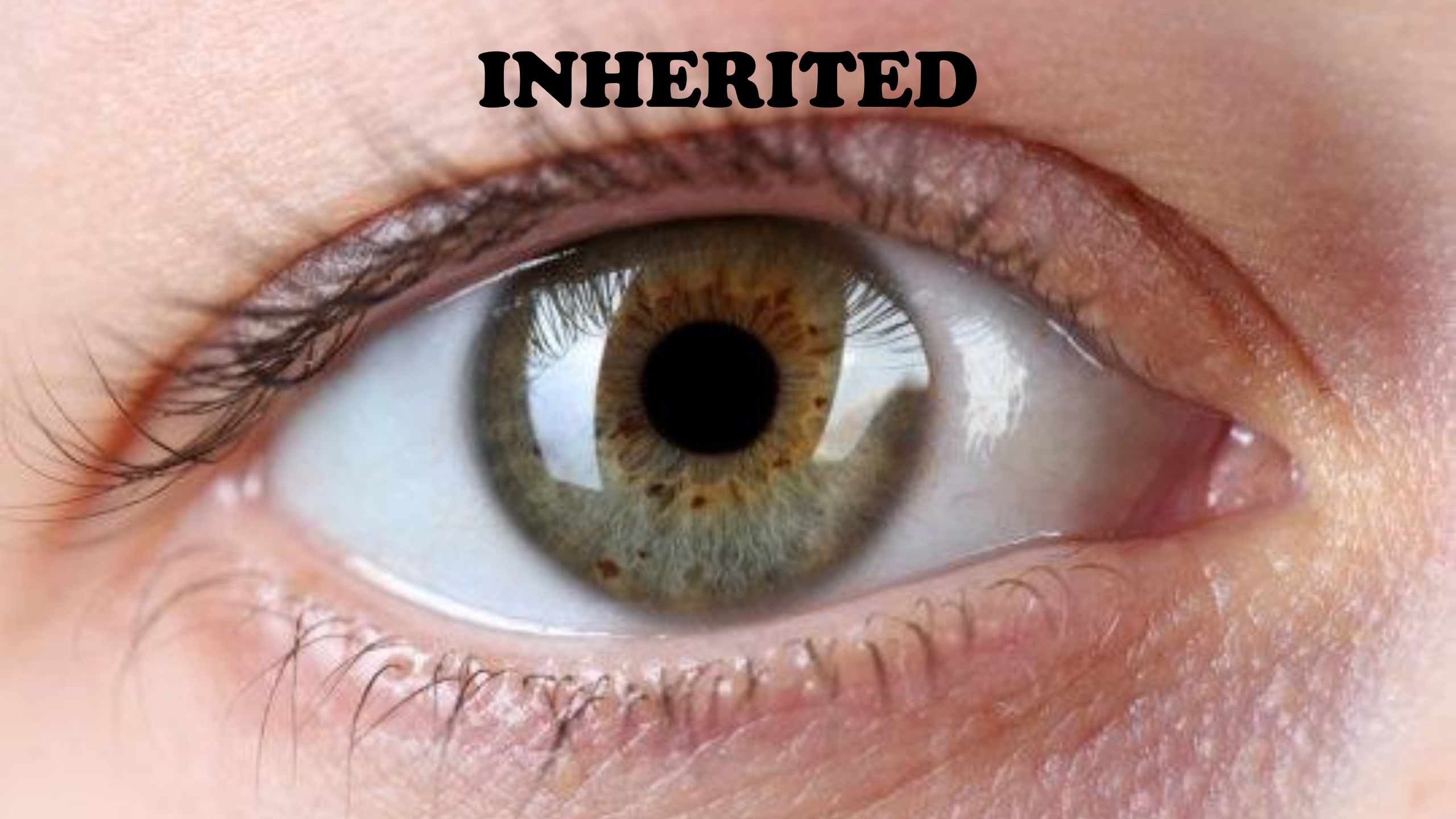
