Discussion Questions:

- What segment of Christ's existence do you think least often about; prior to the incarnation, the incarnation, His life on earth, His ascension, His present ministry, or His second coming and future role? Which do you think of most often?
- Consider the following quote from Sunday's message and then answer why it is such a "big deal" that Christ fulfilled prophecy: "Professors Peter Stoner and Harold Hartzler prepared a mathematical analysis based upon principles of probability and concluded that the odds of someone fulfilling even just 8 of the 61 major Messianic prophecies would be 1 in 10¹⁷ (10 to the 17th power), 1 with 17 zeros behind it. Professor Stoner illustrated that number by taking 10¹⁷ silver dollars and lay them on the face of Texas. It would be enough silver dollars to cover the state of Texas two feet deep. Think about standing in two feet of silver dollars in an area as big as Texas. Now put a mark on one, blindfold a man, let him walk all over, and tell him he can only pick up one silver dollar. The odd he picks up the right one is the same chance that the prophets would have had of writing 8 prophecies that would all come true in one man."
