2 Peter 1:5-7

- (v 5) 'Now for this very reason also, applying all diligence, in your faith supply moral excellence, and in your moral excellence, knowledge;
- (v 6) and in your knowledge, self-control, and in your self-control, perseverance, and in your perseverance, godliness;
- (v 7) and in your godliness, brotherly kindness, and in your brotherly kindness, *love*.
- (v 8) For if these qualities are yours and are increasing, they render you neither useless nor unfruitful in the true knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.'

(but, no Scripture! A high view of God's people; low view of God's Word)

'We are opposed to any exclusive dogma that limits the search for truth and free inquiry, and we encourage work that eases the pain, suffering and degradation inherent in many of the structures of society, as well as work that keeps central to the Christian life fair, open, peaceful, and loving treatment of all human beings.

(<u>but, no Sin</u>! A high view of MY freedom; low view of God's Authority and His Truth)
