5. CONFESSED SPECIFIC SINS. Vs. 6, 9-11

**“Moreover, we have not listened to Thy servants
the prophets, who spoke in Thy name to our
kings, our princes, our fathers, and all the
people of the land.” vs. 6**

“To the Lord our God *belong* compassion and forgiveness, for we have rebelled against Him;” vs. 9

“Nor have we obeyed the voice of the LORD our God, to walk in His teachings which He set before us through His servants the prophets.” Vs. 10

“Indeed, all Israel has transgressed Thy law and turned aside, not obeying Thy voice; so the curse has been poured out on us, along with the oath which is written in the law of Moses the servant of God, for we have sinned against Him.” Vs. 11

A people whom you do not know shall eat up the produce of your ground and all your labors, and you shall never be anything but oppressed and crushed continually.”
