1. ISRAEL'S KING ARRIVED. Vs. 25

"So you are to know and discern that from the issuing of a decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince there will be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks; it will be built again, with plaza and moat, even in times of distress."

Daniel's prophecy: 69 x 7 = 483 years 483 x 360 = 173,880 days between the decree and Palm Sunday.

Our Calendar: The days between March 14th, 445 B.C. And April 6th, 32 A.D. Equals 476 years and 24 days.

$$119 + 173,764 = 173,883$$

$$173,883 - 3 = 173,880$$
