## **4. A RESURRECTION IS GUARANTEED. Vs. 2**

**“And many of those who sleep in the dust of the ground will awake, these to everlasting life, but the others to disgrace and everlasting contempt.”**

**vs. 2**

**\*There is a bodily resurrection ahead for each of us.**

**“...it is appointed for men to die once and after this comes judgment.” Heb. 9:27**

**\*The resurrection of Jesus assures our bodily resurrection.**

**\*There is a resurrection to Life eternal.**

**\*The resurrection to Life is guaranteed by faith.**

**“He who believes in the Son has eternal life...” John 3:36**

**“Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life.”**

**John 5:24**

**\*For some there is a resurrection to misery.**

**Disgrace: An existence of shame, regret and anger.**

**Contempt: An existence which a person will despise.**

**\*The resurrection to misery is also eternal.**

**“And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given to them. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of the testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received the mark upon their forehead and upon their hand; and they came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.
