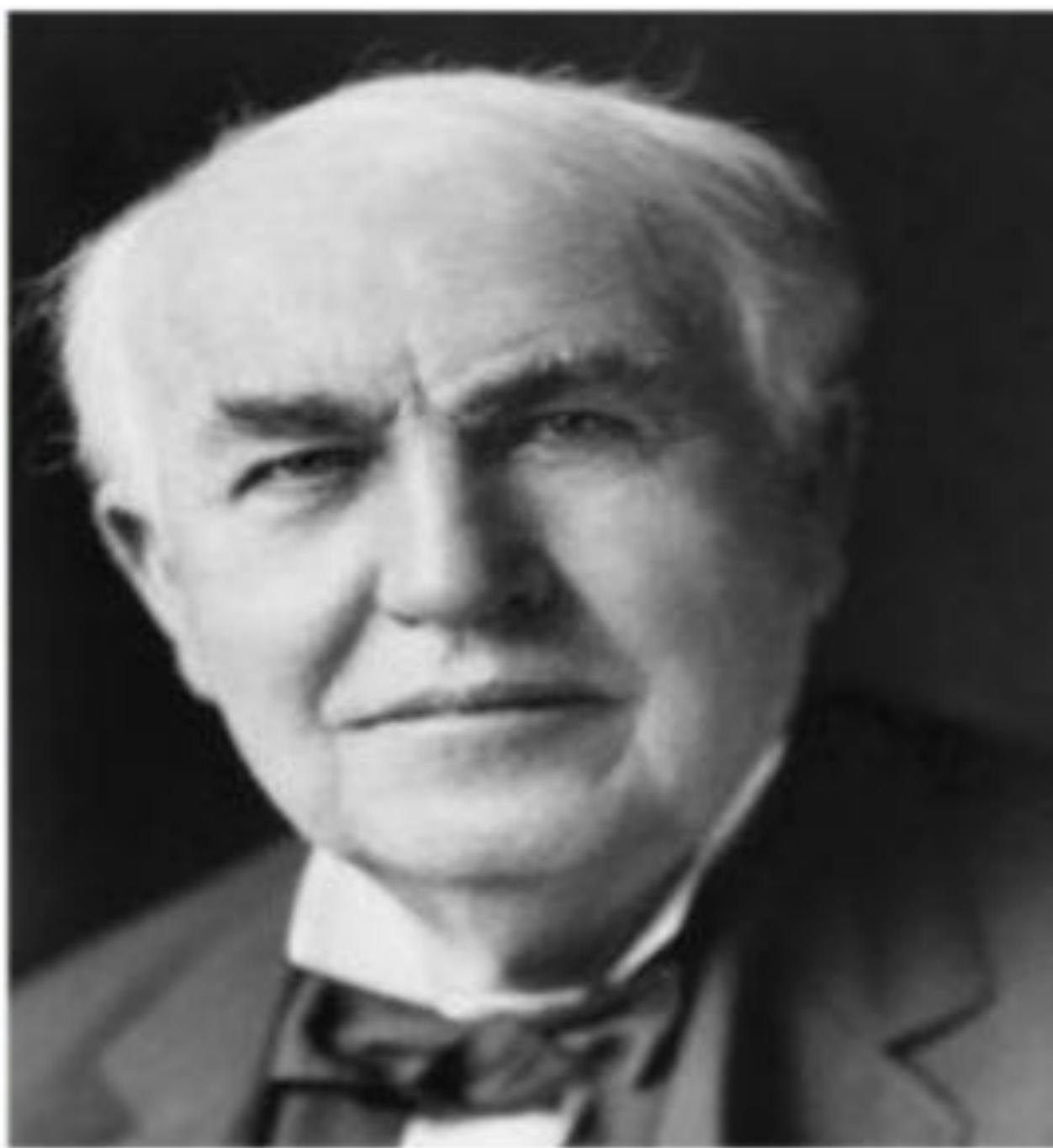


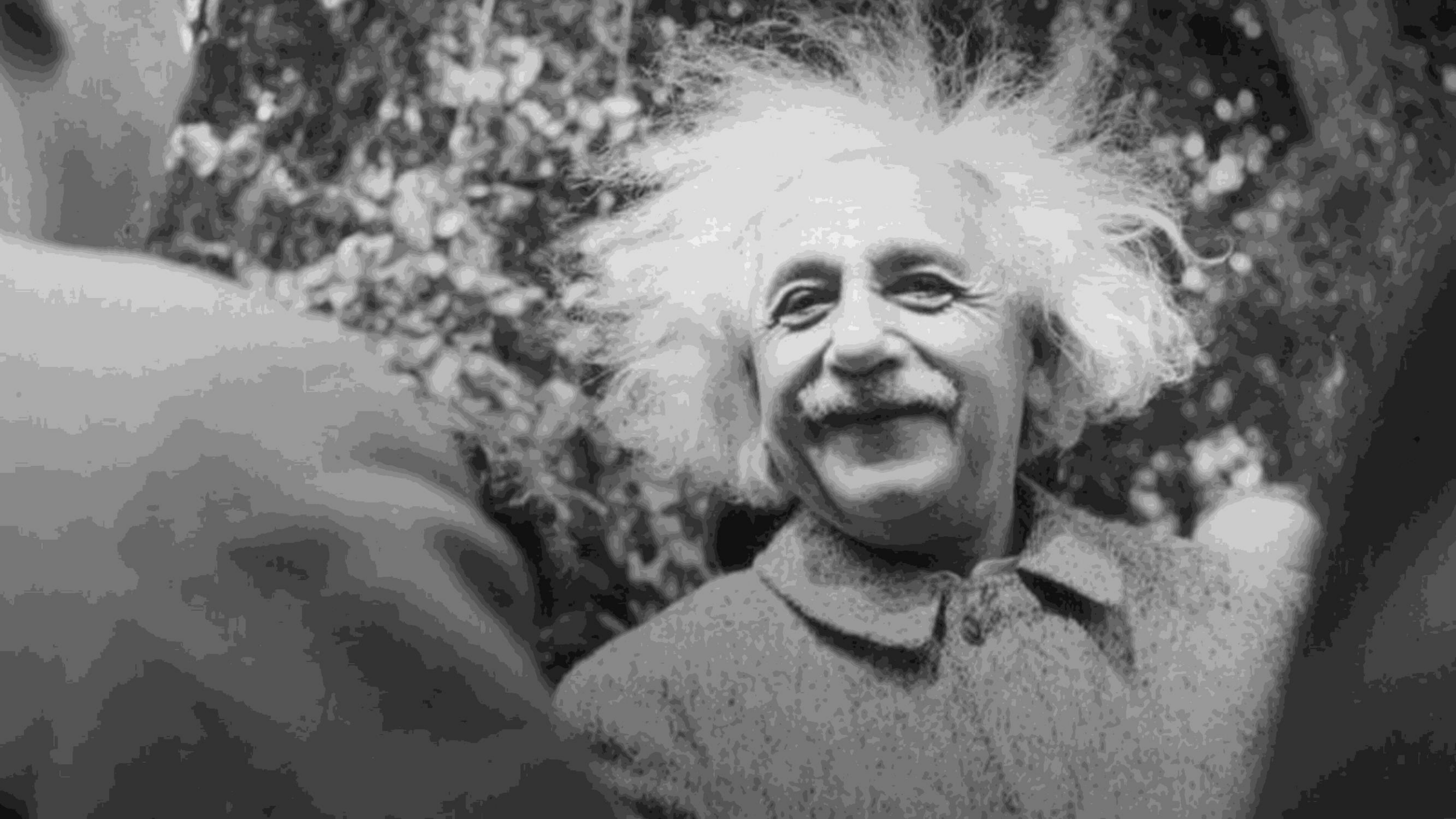

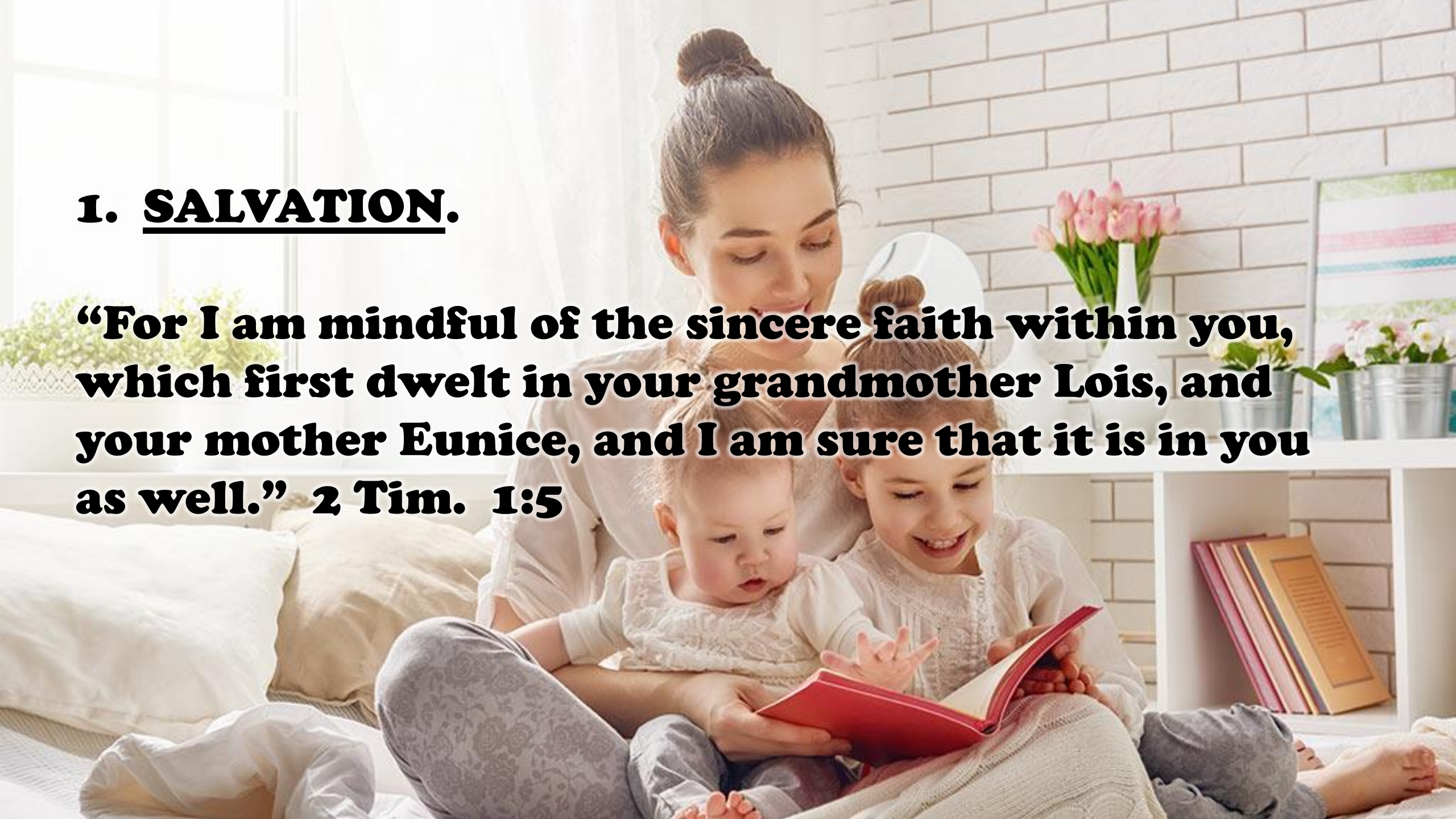






## **1. SALVATION.**

**“He who believes in Him is not judged; he who does not believe has been judged already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.” John 3:18**




**“He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him.” John 3:36**

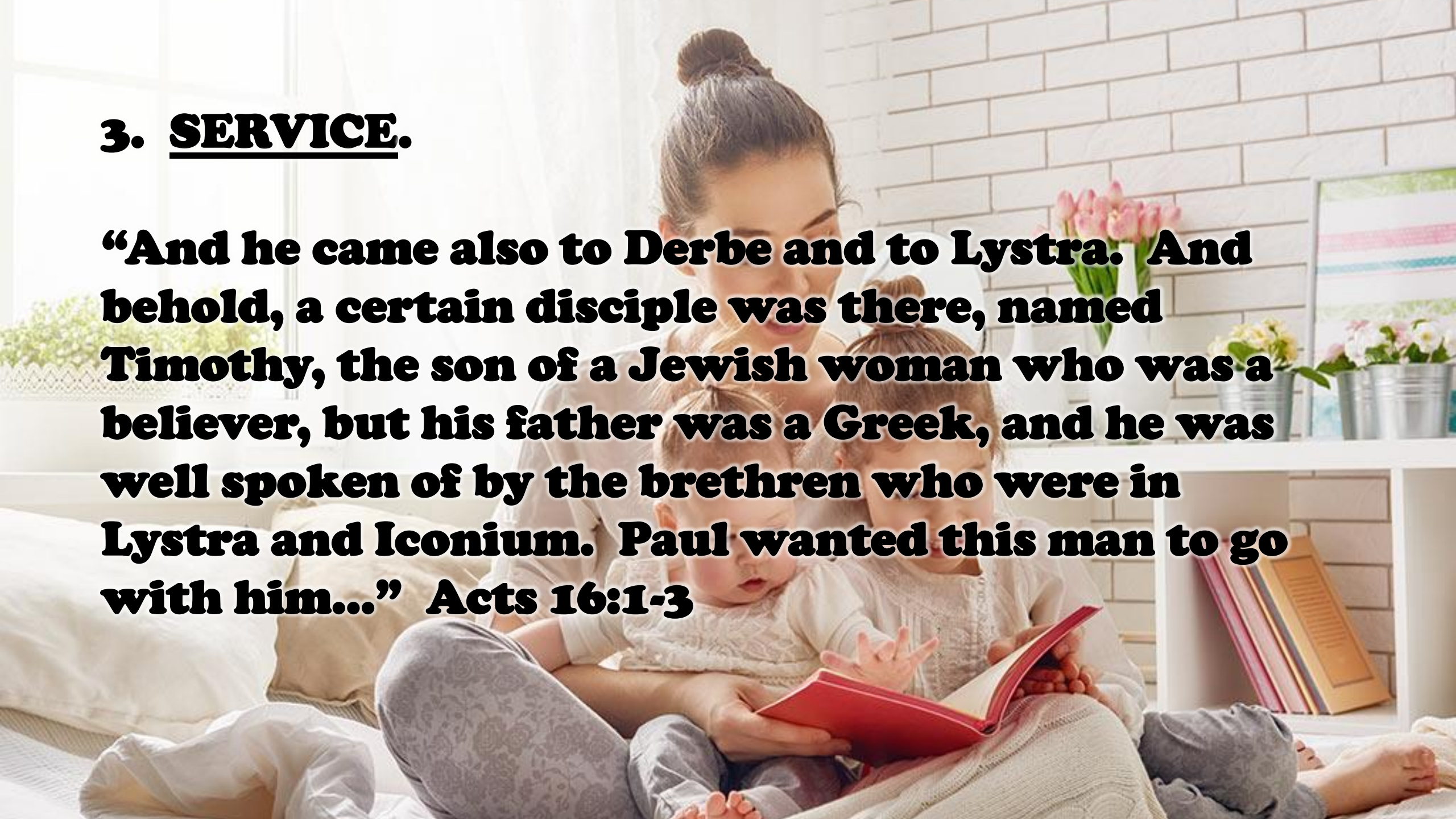


**“That the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.” 2 Tim. 3:17**

**Start early.**

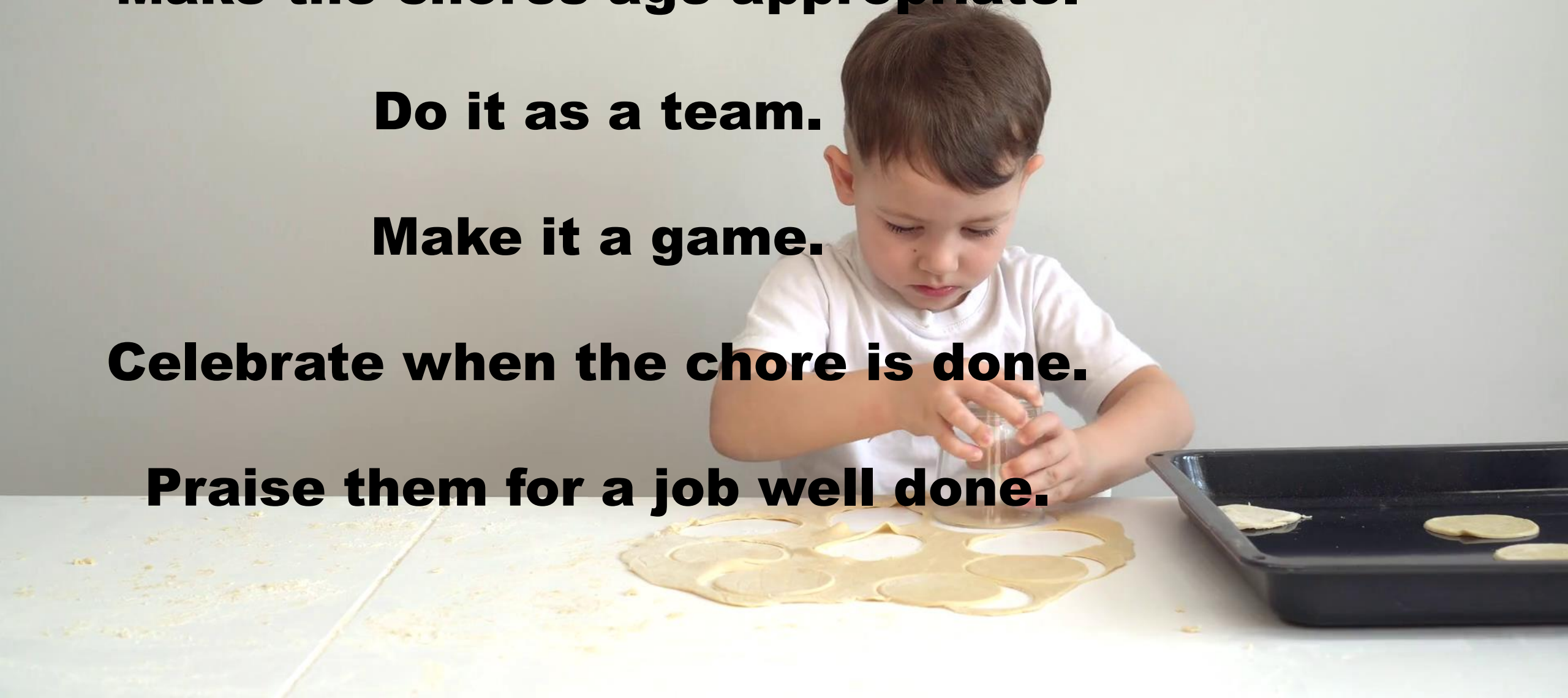
**Make the chores age appropriate.**

**Do it as a team.**

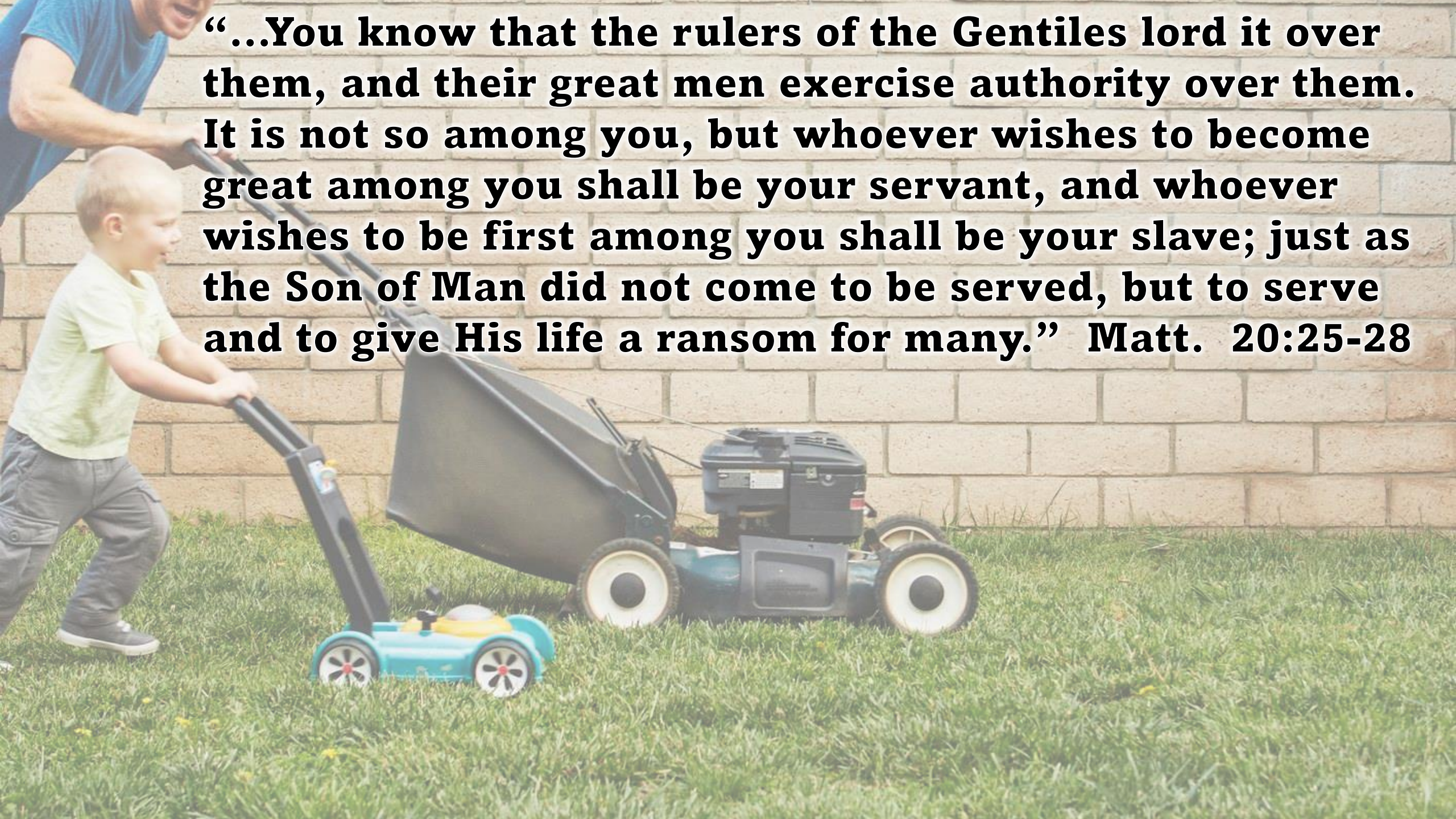
**Make it a game.**
