


TIME TO MOVE ON!??

1. WE HAVE A WORD FROM THE LORD. Vs. 1-2

“Now it came about after the death of Moses the servant of the Lord that the Lord spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses’ servant, saying, ‘Moses My servant is dead; now therefore arise, cross this Jordan, you and all this people, to the land which I am giving to them, to the sons of Israel.’”

“And the Spirit said to Philip, ‘Go up and join this chariot.’” Acts 8:29

“And while Peter was reflecting on the vision, the Spirit said to him, ‘Behold, three men are looking for you. But arise, go downstairs and accompany them without misgivings...’” Acts 10:19-20

“So, being sent out by the Holy Spirit, they went down to Seleucia and from there they sailed to Cyprus.” Acts 13:4

“So then do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is. And do not get drunk...but be filled with the Spirit.” Eph. 5:17-18

2. WE HAVE REASON TO BE COURAGEOUS.

Joshua 1:6, 7, 9

“Be strong and courageous, for you shall give this people possession of the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. Only be strong and very courageous; be careful to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, so that you may have success wherever you go.” vs. 6-7

“Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous! Do not tremble or be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.” vs. 9

“Because he has loved Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him securely on high, because he has known My name. He will call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble; I will rescue him, and honor him. With a long life I will satisfy him, and let him behold My salvation.”
