2. ALWAYS!

A. Do what is right.

"...Respect what is right in the sight of all men."

vs. 17b

"When a man's ways are pleasing to the Lord, He makes even his enemies to be at peace with him." Prov. 16:7

"Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven." Matt. 5:16 B. Be a peacemaker.

"If possible, so far as it depends on you, be at peace with all men." vs. 18

"Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called the sons of God." Matt. 5:9

C. Trust the Lord to bring justice.

"...leave room for the wrath of God, for it is written, 'Vengeance is Mine, I will repay,' says the Lord." vs. 19b

"The eyes of the Lord are in every place, watching the evil and the good." Prov. 15:3 D. Serve the one who's done you wrong.

"But if your enemy is hungry, feed him, and if he is thirsty, give him a drink; for in so doing you will heap burning coals upon his head." vs. 20
