SURVIVING OR THRIVING?



"But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us." Rom. 8:37

To be a Conqueror means that:

Your faith is resolute.

You are progressing in Holiness.

You are seeing results.

What sorts of things may keep us from being a champion, confident in the Love of Christ?

1. EMOTIONAL STUFF. Vs. 35a

"Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress..."

2. PHYSICAL STUFF. Vs. 35b

"...or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?" vs. 35b "I have been in labor and hardship, through many sleepless nights, in hunger and thirst, often without food, in cold and exposure." 2 Cor. 11:27

This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and this is their vindication from me," declares the Lord."
